In our Gospel reading today we have that very familiar story of Jesus feeding the five thousand with two fish and five small loaves. It is a story that talks about the love that Christ has for people not only their spiritual nourishing but indeed the care for peoples physical needs as well. The care for people must be for the whole person, that means that we must look at their physical, mental and spiritual wellbeing. The most remarkable part of the feeding of the five thousand was that Jesus didn't provide just a few morsels for the crowd or maybe just enough for everyone, the story tells us that there was an abundance of food that meant 12 baskets of food was left at the end. Christ is demonstrating the abundance of God's love that is far more than we could ever imagine. We are called to live out of this abundance and share it to the community to which we are called to serve.
