Weekly reflection

Have you ever wondered why the Bible says that "God loves a cheerful giver?" (2 Corinthians 9:7). Joyful giving is a sign that the givers understand that the earth is the Lord's and we are his stewards. Cheerful giving can only come from a heart set on things above, not on earthly things (see Colossians 3:1). God loves a cheerful giver because such givers are investing in heaven, which brings eternal dividends.

When the tabernacle was being built in the Old Testament, people got so caught up in the joy of giving that they had to be 'restrained' from giving more. In fact, Moses had to issue an order, to be sent throughout the camp: "Let no man or woman make anything else as an offering for the sanctuary." It was only then that the people stopped giving. The materials were sufficient for them to do all the work. There was more than enough. (Exodus 36:4-7)

Today we continue the theme of our response to God's rich grace and consider what we can give cheerfully to God of our time, talents and treasures. Blessings
