Weekly reflection

Today is the second Sunday in Advent and the candle we light today is the candle of peace. Isaiah prophesied the coming of the Prince of Peace and yet Jesus said on one occasion, "Do not think that I have come to bring peace but a sword," referring to the divisions and strife that the gospel would bring in lives of those who followed him, rejecting the faith of their fathers. The apostle Peter enjoins us to pursue peace and in the beatitudes, Jesus proclaimed that peace makers are blessed. So it's an important but problematic theme. May God open our eyes to how we can be at peace with God, with ourselves and with our neighbours and to how we can be peacemakers in all those contexts.
