Weekly reflection

This will be my last Bulletin reflection so I do want to thank you all for your welcome, prayers and friendship. Glenys and I have really enjoyed becoming part of the fellowship of the Oxley Uniting Church and will have many fond memories of this season.

Today's theme is based around the words, "Knowledge puffs up, but love builds up," found in 1 Corinthians 8:1. The broader discussion is around the eating of meat that had been sacrificed to idols, a conundrum for which it is hard – but not entirely impossible -to find a parallel in our modern context. Nonetheless, Paul's conclusion about differing matters of opinion in the faith community is as modern as tomorrow. That we are always to consider the feelings and vulnerability of others, particularly those whose faith is not as strong as it might be. More on this in the sermon.
