Weekly reflection

Mystery - Misery or Miracle?

Stephen Furtick (Pastor of Elevation Church in America) says in one of his books, "most people in our churches today can't see what is, or what can be, because all they can see is what was". I am not asking you to debate this but to ponder it. Tradition and the ways of yesteryear has its place, but if we are consumed by it, we will indeed struggle to 'see' new possibilities. Our future, we might argue, is a mystery! My question is how do we cope with 'the mystery of it all'? How do we cope with the unknown – the uncertain? - those things that can't or won't be squeezed into our boxes of normality? Does it give us sense of misery or can we be expectant for a miracle from a supernatural peace, presence, and power?

Things were going pear-shaped for the people in Colossae. Paul reminds them that, despite what the world might argue - in the coming of Jesus, the mystery of life and our future is solved. We need only focus on Jesus to unravel that question from last week – what's next?

Christ is our message! (Col. 1: 28). Nothing more – nothing less!

As Lent begins this week – let's be a people who expect fresh revelations of Jesus' call on our lives and be eager to stand up and declare His Promises.
