Weekly reflection

The Road Less Travelled?

Scott Peck wrote a book by this title. In it he contends that the ways we often choose to go in life may be easy but often, far from the best. His recommended path to spiritual enlightenment includes four key elements: discipline, love, personal religion, and grace. According to Peck, without these four qualities, we risk spiritual stagnation which almost certainly will play out in our health physically and emotionally. While not a Christian book per se, it offers some sound advice. From my own experience, the Road of (and to) Release may well be called the same. It is not a road travelled often or well. Most of us want to keep on with the easy way – the ways that are known – whether they be productive or not.

Isaiah's road is a pathway that results in 'delight in the Lord' (Isaiah 58: 14). Yet, he argues strongly, that to secure such delight, we must contend with what he calls the "ifs". If, then. There is no 'then' without acknowledgement of and commitment to, the "if". Jesus echoes the same pathway in stipulating that to find Him, we must deny ourselves, take up our cross and follow Him. Not easy, but oh so rewarding! (Matthew 10: 38). My prayer is that we discover and embark upon the Road of Release and never let it depart from us. And Lent is a great time to take up the challenge!
