Mobilising Mission!

Ever challenged the norm? Ever questioned the status quo? Ever swum against the tide? For several years I was a part of a significant crowd of over 1,000 people (young and old) who participated in the Relay for Life. Basically, we formed teams and walked - between us - from 3pm on a Saturday afternoon through till 8am on the Sunday Morning. While I was doing one of my stints – following the group in front – this crazy thought came to me. What would happen if I started walking the other way? So, with no warning, I just turned around and began walking the opposite way to the other 700 folk (I reckon) who were walking at that time. I did get to eyeball lots of people. Sadly perhaps, I got lots of not so nice gestures and yes even a few not so nice expletives, but I continued. After I had mastered two full laps of this oval a strange thing happened. Others began to turn around. And before long everyone was again walking the same way – but in a different direction.

Our 'mission' imperative is, in part, "Going Christ's Way". Did you know that His way was, and is, often against the status quo? To mobilise that statement means to not only imagine Christ's Way but to live it. Paul, just as he is grateful for the way in which his imprisonment has helped others in Philippi stay focussed, urges us to have "courage to speak the Word of God without fear" (Philippians 1: 14). That was Paul's way. That was Jesus' way. That needs to be our way!
