Weekly reflection THE X FACTOR?

Some of you may remember this as a showcase of talent on TV where people from all backgrounds ages and localities – mostly unknown - enlisted to perform in the pursuit of the coveted prize. The 'mostly unknown' was the rationale for the name. The unknown becomes known, gifts and talents are highlighted, and a change of lifestyle often follows. I personally knew one young girl, from Gympie, who went on the show and came 5th in her particular year and while a long way from winning, shared how it changed her life. "It was a little daunting at times, but I knew I wasn't alone. I had the support of my family and friends. It was like I was being taken to a whole new level when I performed." In chatting with her it became obvious that while she was glad to be accepted onto the show, the real buzz was in the performing. In terms of Church language, perhaps this could be likened to not just hearing but doing. And then not only doing but being. In other words, being who we are called to be. The buzz comes when we activate our faith relying on the presence and power of the Holy Spirit (the X Factor) to lift us to a whole new level of living.Today - Pentecost - we celebrate the coming of the Spirit birthing the 'Church' with presence and power. One of my greatest aches is that we, as followers of Jesus, often struggle to share who we have living within. You see - we readily accept the gift of the Spirit while we struggle to receive and activate the workings of the Spirit. Its not either / or. It ought to be both / and! Jesus left and promised His Spirit to empower us to fulfill His mission of discipling – while we have breath! Let's not be afraid of His power - let's embrace it. Maybe today we would be well served to hear the words of Peter (Acts 2:14) slightly rephrased for our context: "People of Oxley and all who live in neigbouring suburbs, let this be known to you and heed my words...".
