Weekly reflection DIVINE PERSPECTIVE?

Why else would God decide to send His Spirit after Jesus ministry had been fulfilled, other than to give us all a divine perspective on living? Without such a perspective - or we might say lens - we are of little use to God's mission or ours. Yet should we choose to embrace all of God – Father, Son and Spirit – we can do the impossible and see the impossible become reality. I call this extra-ordinary life one of balance. I am sure we have all heard of and maybe even been told that balance is good. I know from my past life in investments that a balanced portfolio is seen (Unless you are very close to retirement) as the most lucrative over the long term. We are reminded often by medical folk as well as Gym instructors etc. that a balance between food and exercise is paramount. And I am sure there are other examples. The point is simple! If we listen to these 'instructors' and seek to obey and bring balance into our physical and emotional life, why is it that we often struggle to hear the 'instruction' from God to bring balance into our Spiritual life - which is far more important? Paul reminds us that what happened at Pentecost (our celebration last week) gave us the 'Spirit of Adoption' such that our spirits align with His Spirit, making us heirs of both Father and Son (Romans 8: 15). Just as the triune God does not and cannot operate independently from each other, nor should we try and operate independent of the three persons of God – now at our disposal! Later, Paul writes that we have been blessed with every good spiritual gift that we might honour the Father and give glory to the Son (Eph. 1: 3-6). The balanced life is our inheritance - as children of God – and one we can live in now yet also quarantees us a fantastic future for eternity. Let's embrace ALL of His gifts and live balanced – the divine perspective!
