PREVAILING PRESENCE!

Aunty Lillian is one of the tribal elders of the Gubbi Gubbi people – passionate leader and persistent advocate to Government and community of her people's customs, culture and of the need to become much more intentional with - what she calls - 'absolute reconciliation'. Over 3 decades of lobbying finally heralded recently widespread recognition of the Indigenous folk who gave their all, alongside many Anglo Australians, in the defense of this great land. Chatting about that 'wait', she said "I think they just got sick of me – I think my presence makes 'em shudder now". Interesting statement! 'Presence' demands a relationship and where the relationship is soured, presence can become a real threat. Yet, the converse is also true. Where presence is valued and affirmed, relationships can be empowering and valuable. 2 Samuel 6 seems to validate this. The Ark of the Covenant was symbolic of both God's covenant relationship with His chosen people and His Presence right there as they journeyed. The chapter paints the issues that arose when the Ark was mistreated (alienation and death) and respected (praise and power).

Does Jesus' presence prevail in our life? Do we embrace His power and rejoice in the relationship His presence demands?
