#### **PASTOR'S PONDERINGS**

#### B - MAD



15 years ago yesterday, Steve Irwin, aka the Crocodile Hunter, died of a stingray barb that pierced his heart. His tributes were many and varied but perhaps best summed up as "an iconic naturalist who loved what he did, exuding confidence, excitement, and enthusiasm every waking moment." His catch cry – CRIKEY – was as much a part of him as was his khaki uniform and his seemingly invincible rock star type status. He would play with animals and reptiles that most of us would only gaze upon through reinforced glass and / or large fences. Some thought he was mad and it was just an ego trip seeking attention (crazy way to get attention). I recall being asked by a grade 4 girl the day after his death, "Pastor Dave, was Mr. Crocodile Man a Christian?" I didn't know the answer to that and still don't. Yet, it seems to me that his legacy – his approach to the environment and to its inhabitants (both large and small) provides a modern day example of the way in which each one if us ought to approach our calling to be disciples of Jesus – ie. with passion, excitement and enthusiasm – with a 'no fear' mindset. We continue our reflections on sections of James. He reminds us that it is not good enough to just say the right words, turn up in the right places, and look the part. Indeed, it is not enough to have faith if it is lying dormant and not exercised or put to the test. The Passion Translation puts it this way: "So then faith that doesn't involve action is phony" (James 2: 17). Our actions should verify our faith! Ask yourself these questions: "Am I MAD for Jesus? Am I living and radiating the love and mercy of Christ with passion? Am I declaring through my words and behaviours – my attitudes and ethics – the transforming presence and power of our Lord? What is the CRIKEY factor of my walk with God and do I share it with the world that they may see Christ in me? Answer them honestly and ask God to reveal how we might respond! I'm happy to B – MAD! That is **BE to MAKE A DIFFERENCE!** And you? And us? Blessings Dave
