RESPONSE – ABILITY!

I cried because I had no shoes until I met a man who had no feet! Birdie, Birdie in the sky - dropped its cargo in my eye. As I wiped it from my eye - I thanked the Lord that cows can't fly! Interesting comments aren't they? What do they have in common? I guess both in different ways remind us that despite how bad things may get for us at times, things could be worse! I sat with a lady some time back who had huge ulcers on both her legs they were ugly, weeping sores which made walking almost impossible. Yet - when I visited her - she was all smiles, seemingly oblivious to the smell and mess all over her lower legs and feet. I remember vividly she telling me, "I can't complain - they're ugly but I still got them unlike so many others." The next time I visited her she told me that doctors had confirmed she would lose both legs from just above the knee. "Oh well", she said, "I'll still be alive won't I – its only my legs – not my life." About a month later now in a Blue Care facility - I called in to see her again. Still smiling. She was so proud of what she called her stumps. "Done a great job didn't they?" A month later she died! And I can imagine her saying something like - oh well - it's just my body - not my spirit! That woman taught me so much about prayer and praise! She found incredible strength in both. She would spend hours praying for her family and friends – for the church and for the salvation of all those who treated her. She spoke to everyone about Jesus and the love He had for her – and them! And, she would praise God (seriously) for what God had done in her life! WOW! Such inspiration! James says that our response in life is to pray when we suffer and praise when we're happy (James 5: 13). I take that to mean that no matter what happens to us or around us - we need to seize the ability to respond to God. That, friends, is our RESPONSE-ABILITY! In prayer and praise we need to confident and constant. I love the quote from War Room – it's a movie we all need to watch – "Victory doesn't come by accident." **Blessings Dave**
