EXAM TIME!

"Remember next week its exam time!" I cringe when I think of those words even now. It was a lot worse though back when I, like so many others, had to confront such things. I really struggled with exams - where I was supposed to commit to memory things in a text -book or what was taught by the teacher or both? I tried all the tricks – like trying to create acronyms for key concepts – numbers to represent different things – you name it I tried it. I remember in my first and only music exam I ever sat – I committed to memory the well-known "Every Good Boy Deserves Fruit" for the five lines on the treble clef. I was so chuffed that I got it! I got to the exam and yes that was one of the questions. At least I would get one right! I answered that question confidently. Problem was I didn't remember if the "E" was at the bottom or the top? Where does the acronym start? So, I did what I often did in exams – guessed – and I got it wrong. EXAMS – not for me! Well at least not those written sort!

Jesus calls us to examine ourselves constantly to assess how we are going with living in His Kingdom! We might call it an examination of conscience — a term that will be very familiar with any who have been involved in Emmaus or Chrysalis over the years — but a discipline we should all be familiar with given the biblical imperative to 'seek first the Kingdom of God' (Matthew 6:33) and follow Jesus as the One who is above all and in all (Hebrews 1:3) — who died for us and offers us salvation and grants to us a priceless inheritance for eternity. I pray that we all may embark on such exams with regularity such that we might pray with David in saying, "Declare me innocent O Lord for I have acted with integrity; I have trusted in the Lord without wavering" (Psalm 26:1).
