PASTOR'S PONDERINGS



THE GREATER GOOD!

For several years, I was what the Uniting Church at one time called 'A Community Minister'. That's how I started my ministry journey! A community minister was an un-ordained role, a little like the then lay pastor. The difference was that it did not have to be a paid role and the intent was to allow lay people to 'step up' into ministry from within the congregation of which they were a member. I received permission to do the sacraments and in essence I did everything an ordained person did - just didn't have the 'title' - and to be honest - that never concerned me! It did however concern a few others. I remember sharing with one of my mentors at the time and he asked me some very pointed questions! "Why haven't you given yourself to God's mission for the greater good?" I had no idea what he meant - greater good? He shared with me that maybe what God was doing in my life – the ministry seemed to be growing - at that time was pointing me toward a bigger goal than the local community I was then in ministry with. And then he popped this next question, "Is ministry all about you or more about what God wants to do through you? It took a while but eventually I discovered that I was limiting God's intention for me and indeed limiting myself by closing the door to new opportunities for the greater good – God's greater good. Ordination followed!

Job knew the greater good despite being tested beyond most human's capacity and being subjected to numerous arguments suggesting he was 'bad'. He stood up to his accusers (Job 23:12) and there are times when we need to 'step up' for the greater good. Other times we need to 'let go' for the same greater good (Mark 10: 21). I pray we might be a people who strive for the greater good – God's greater good!
