CONNECTING THE DOTS......!

Am I the only one who remembers these pages with numbered dots all over them? The ones that challenged little minds to grab a pencil and join them all up? One had to follow the numbers and if one did it correctly – behold – a picture would emerge. I remember, as a young boy, being handed these 'puzzles' from Mum (probably to quieten me) and attempting to connect the dots to see the 'prize' when completed. And at that young age if one gave up in disgust because it was all too hard or the next number surely wasn't there – the picture prize wasn't to be discovered! Completion was the key! Of course, as we get older those sorts of simple attention grabbers lose their appeal and become boring. However, it is as we get older and more mature that we need to learn to connect some different dots in our quest to live under God's reign.

The encounter between Jesus and Bartimaeus (Mark 10: 46-52) is interesting. 'Bart' is blind and hears of Jesus and immediately starts yelling to get Jesus' attention. In his mind he begins to connect some dots! If only I can get to Jesus — I've heard about Him! Enter opposition! A blind beggar — why would Jesus be interested in him? The disciples shunned him! But he was persistent. He kept yelling and ultimately his final dots were connected, and his eyes were opened. I pray that as we embark on our journey together as God's people, we might not quit when things get tough — and that our focus might be forever on the 'God picture' awaiting each of us.
