KINGDOM OPERATION..

Most of us have heard them! Many have told them! And once they start, they seem to keep going! What are they? Is this a quiz? No – not really! Although it does sound a bit like one of those cryptic trivia questions, doesn't it? I'll save you the agony. They are snake stories. And yes – I guess growing up in the country I have my fair share of them. But most of them are for another day. It is rather interesting however to take a relatively new snake-skin along to a school show and tell RI lesson! Yes – I did that! It was about 6 feet long – and on examination I could tell where the head used to be, and all the markings were still intact. I lay it out on the concrete corridor prior to the start just outside the door to the classroom. And when the kids saw it there was range of reactions! Some screamed, some ran away, some were curious (from a long distance) and then there was one who went right up to it, then proclaimed, "Ah it's nothing. It's just an old skin. What was inside has come out".

Fascinating! For that snake to survive it had to come out and leave its existing enclosure. The very house that enabled it to move. So too, we, as Jesus followers, need to leave behind those enclosures that would keep us from living and moving in His Kingdom. In the dialogue between Pilate and Jesus (John 18: 34-38) we note that when confronted by Jesus and a new way of operating, Pilate reneged. He retreated to what he knew! He couldn't quite come at leaving his house of comfort and security. What about you and I? In whose Kingdom are we operating? The fullness of life that Jesus offers is outside the houses of our past – no matter how spectacular they may have been! It's risky to leave one's house and begin operating within God's Kingdom because it is, for the most part, - very different – challenging and often confronting. Yet, we must ask ourselves, "What's it mean for you and I and us to call Jesus our King?"
