PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

PERFECT PEACE....

There they were! Awaiting the arrival of someone special – in fact the bride! All had been prepared. The big moment would soon be upon them. People started arriving. There was lots of chatter and laughs as they anticipated the climax of months of agonizing organization. And then – the groom's mother exclaims rather indignantly and loudly – where's the Priest? Has anyone seen him? No, they hadn't. The news soon got around and there was a nervous silence. Anxiety prevailed! Where was he? Well – he had forgotten the wedding and he was mowing his yard. The phone rang and his wife answered – embarrassed she yells – "you have a wedding – now"! Thinking quickly – he yells back: "tell them I'm coming and to be ready". The guests (and the bridal party) responded positively and peacefully. All the anxiety lifted – peace now prevailed! The Priest was coming and that was enough!

That is the message of Advent – "I'm coming". Jesus is coming and our task is to ensure we are ready for his arrival. The question we have to answer is: can we be like those guests and in the waiting and hoping (remember last week) for the coming, can we be at peace and be proclaimers of peace, such that the anxiety and fear that so often prevails in our world is at worst – eased and at best eradicated? John the Baptist could well have been called John the Peace Provider! Luke records it this way: "And you child will be called the prophet of the Most High" (Luke 1: 76) and among other important tasks, you will "guide our feet into the way of peace" (V. 79). The way of Peace is the Jesus way! John proclaimed it! And we are to be modern day John the Baptist's and be the conduit for His peace! Can we and others find His perfect peace amid the trials and tribulations of our day? Oh yes – it's a gift! It just needs to be received, opened it and lived!
