#### SUSTAINABLE JOY....

Mum and Dad had 5 kids! I am the second eldest - I have an older brother who some of you know and three younger sisters who most would not know. Linda is the youngest. I was still pretty young but I recall the day she was born - 26 July 1970. Dad took me to the hospital to see this new addition to our family. I specifically remember three things about that morning. First, I didn't get to cuddle her. I think Dad must have been afraid I'd drop her - who me?? Second - it was a Sunday! I was excited not just to see a new born baby but I got out of going to church that day - a win win! Third - and the best part - she bears the name I chose! Well - her middle name anyway! I don't remember the conversation but Mum has since told me that she and dad were trying to think of a second name - they had decided on Linda as her first. Dad turned to me and asked me what I thought! I was so excited at the time and apparently said something like: "Well its Sunday - it's a happy day - this is a happy moment let's call her JOY! Linda Joy had a certain ring to it - and still does. What a JOY to name one of your siblings! I, to this day, am quite chuffed at that. Here's my point!

Like any child, like any teenager, like any young adult, like any grown adult, 'joy' did not always match her behaviour or her attitudes. Yet, her name declared it anyway! Joy was a part of her identity even in those crazy difficult times. And it is the same with the gift that Jesus offers us and we particularly remember and celebrate during this season of advent. And Joy can be ours in both the good and the bad - the ups and downs of life! Our Joy can be sustained regardless because it is not conditional on us, our thoughts or feelings! Rather it s based on WHO is yet to come! "Shout for joy, rejoice and exult with all your heart, because the Lord your God is in your midst" (Zeph. 3: 14,17).
