PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

LOVE THAT LASTS....



Some things just stick with you! It was a while ago now but I haven't forgotten it. I was in my last week at the School for which I had been chaplain for almost 9 years. I had seen kids start as little Preps and been a part of their whole Primary education. I treasure those years of front-line ministry. There were lots of times when I felt so out of my depth, times I felt I was making a difference and times when I wondered why I was there! But this moment in my last week was special! I was in a Grade 2 classroom saying my good byes. As I finished chatting with them - many of them literally at my feet - one girl whispered - "don't go yet". She ran off and as I was at the door of the room – she returned and gave me this gift – "this is for you, it's a cd player", she said with a tear in her eye. What I held was actually a Special K breakfast box that she had cut and glued in such a way that it looked the size of a small CD player and it even had a spot for the CD to be put in! I received it from her and before I could say anything – she said, "it may not look or feel real – but it's real from me." I have never forgotten those words and yes, I still have that made up cardboard 'CD player'. (I often wonder if she remembers that moment – I guess she would be finished Senior now). I really believe she gave that gift not just as a token of her relationship with the School Chaplain but out of love.

I suspect for many of us – dare I say all of us - there are times in our lives when we question God's love for us! We doubt His existence, we think he's abandoned us. And at these times I can almost Him repeating the same words as that Grade 2 girl. My love may not look or feel real – but hey know this – it's real from me! And then we need to decide what we do with His gift. Now I certainly didn't need a bit of old cardboard but I doubt that was the real gift – the gift to me was her love expressed in her actions. God's love calls us to believe it and act upon it. His love is a love that lasts! It's not situational nor generational – it is relational; it is personal; it is eternal (John3:16&17).
