THE RIDE OF LIFE....



I assume that many of you know that deep down I am country kid. I love the bush. I love the outback. I love the sense of being at one with the land and its freedom. As we know though such freedom is not without its risks. I kid you not when I say that I've had a taipan slither over my feet, been bitten by a red back spider, and a few other things and as scary as they all were at the time - none of them have deterred me from its splendour! Its OK - I was always known as a young child growing up as 'the crazy one'. On one occasion, I went horse riding on a property with a few others and I was given this particular horse which was the biggest the property owners had.
