PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

THRIVING NOT SURVIVING



"It's not what happens to you: It's what you do about it." That's a quote on the front cover of a book and that quote captivated my interest and imagination. I remember then casting eyes to the title of the book - 'The man who would not be defeated'. I am not what I call an avid reader like some but do enjoy a good biography or even better an autobiography. I bought this book on the strength of its cover and while the old saying: 'you cant judge a book by its cover' is quite often true in this case it was very wrong. Here's a quick summary which can never do justice to the whole but it may help illustrate my point in sharing this - and that is - the desire Jesus has for us to thrive in life no matter what happens.

Bill Mitchell was in a horrific motorbike / truck collision in which gas exploded burning 65% of his body. His fingers burnt so bad they were lost, his face was permanently scarred - you get the picture. Four years later he was in an airplane disaster where he lost the use of both legs and became a paraplegic. Two accidents, any one of them, almost surely would be the end of quality living for most of us. Yet Bill somehow didn't let such obstacles get in the way of his ambitions. His drive to thrive in life. It's a fascinating read! Subsequent to both accidents he was elected Mayor of his region in the States , shares his story with thousands around the world and has had a huge impact into countless lives .

The book is silent regarding any experience with God. I don't know of Bill's spiritual background or if he is a Christian. Yet his message resonates deep with so many Christian spiritual truths - that the power of He who is within us is stronger then the power of the world that is around us. Mark Wall, lead singer with Casting Crowns, says to thrive today we need to dig deep and reach out. That's the message of Jeremiah 17 and Psalm 1. Are we happy to be mere survivors - just existing or are we ready to to thrive and live the abundance Jesus wants for us? Shalom - Dave.
