PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

LEAN, LEARN AND LEAD!



One of the real joys I had as a Chaplain to a large Primary School was that I got to go on almost every school camp or excursion from walking around the park (Preps and Grade 1) to being away for a week at an adventure camp for Grades 6 & 7 (back then) to bussing it to Canberra and back over 10 days. One of the real challenges I had as a Chaplain to a Primary School was that the senior kids expected the Chaplain to do everything we asked them to do - including those kind of way out scary things - like on one occasion conquering the high ropes course. So there I was all suited up and showing no fear (externally) climbed the tree secured myself by a rope and carabiner to a rope above (just in case) and began to walk across this rather small piece of wire - about 20 feet above the ground. Kids are screaming from below and I thought—ok I can do this its not as bad as I thought - so I started to go a bit quicker and then it happened. My foot slipped off the wire, and instinctively I let go of the rope above and grabbed the rope attached to me - bad move! The kids screamed - they thought I had done it on purpose and they were just laughing and watching! What's next? I tried to hide my fear but I was not too sure of my next move. I had to get my feet back on the wire but I couldn't do that without hanging on to the bigger rope above. It was then I remembered the words above that I had learnt at a leadership development workshop. I figured if I could get one foot onto the wire and push out it would make the wire tighter and should enable me to get re-attached properly. It worked - but not before some adrenalin rush as I leaned to full extension between the wire and rope glaring at the ground below me. I learnt a lot that day about me and what not to do when one loses ones footing. The next day I was asked to lead another group doing the same thing and I felt equipped from the day before. Lean, learn and lead. I wonder, as church, if we are not like Peter (Luke 9:33) and lean into the spectacular, learn from it and stay there instead of leading others to the same experience?
