PASTOR'S PONDERINGS



PROMOTING PRESENCE....

For the 9 and a bit years whilst in Gympie I played squash competitively every Tuesday then subsequently Wednesday nights. I was not in the top division but when I left town, I was the top player of the division in which I was placed – so I was the top of the bottom – if that makes sense. Squash is an intriguing game and is extremely competitive particularly at the very top levels. When I first started playing – in Brisbane around 1982 – I was told by our captain that the most crucial part of the game is "your presence". What he meant (took me a while to understand) was that if you can learn to occupy the middle of the court by your presence you will make things easier for yourself and harder for the opponent. "You must promote your presence every moment. Make your opponent feel it." I think that advice back then is still very apt for squash players of any level today."

Our Christian pilgrimage is a little different although the benefit of 'presence' is real. The difference is of course that is not *our* presence we are promoting but *Christs*. Paul reminds us that in Christ we are new creations (2 Cor. 5: 17). We are no longer who we used to be. We have been raised up and as a result, we have the responsibility to promote His presence through us, such that the world may know whose we are! Promoting Christ's presence through our words and actions creates an invitation for others to 'come' - as we have been reflecting on over the last 2 weeks – and be brought into that loving, living, dynamic, ever changing, often challenging relationship with Jesus; Paul calls it reconciliation! (v. 18). Does Christ's presence hold a position of pre-eminence within you? Can others detect your passion for Christ? Lent is a time to prepare ourselves for 'the cross' and its impact on our own lives. The call of the Cross is to know Jesus and make Him known – to be intentional, invitational, know our identity and live in and promote His intimate presence.
