ARE YOU AVAILABLE....

Before you somewhat blindly say yes to this question, think through whether you really are - no matter what? How much are you prepared to give? Are you happy to put aside your own plans for the cause of another? John is a good mate of mine. One of those forever friendships that distance or time will never separate. It was a Wednesday. He and I had just got home (Gympie) having driven from Charleville that day and from Birdsville the day before. It was the culmination of a week with Frontier Services helping them raise funds at the Birdsville races. To say we were both exhausted would be an understatement. It was about 7.30pm and we were sitting at the kitchen table finishing a cuppa - reflecting on the 10 days now gone - just before John went off to his home. Then the phone rang! It was for me! I answered it while John remained sitting – thinking he would wait until I had finished with the call. What had been a joyful chat along with a sense of relief that we were home was turned on its head in a spit second. My best mate from school years – the guy who taught me so much about life – we literally became blood brothers – was dead. He died a few days earlier while on a fishing trip off the Townsville Coast. The funeral was to be in Townsville on Friday! I was speechless. John knew instantly that something was wrong! Eventually I shared with him the news. "You need to be at that funeral" he paused and then said unequivocally - "I'll drive you - we'll go together". We left together the next day - drove through the night - went to the funeral and chatted to his family and friends before driving through the night to be back home on Saturday mid-morning. John made himself available for me! What a gift? I'll never forget it!

That's the spirit of availability and giving that we see as Jesus rests (John 12) before his approach to the cross! It's about who you are and what you are prepared to offer to He who has recreated you to be who you are! Availability is commitment personified! As we continue our journey to the cross this Lenten season – where's your commitment? Are you available?
