#### **PASTOR'S PONDERINGS**





I was never a great swimmer. Sure, I learnt how to swim, and I guess I can hold my own in the water but compared to those who are 'swimmers' I just don't relate. I watch the Swimming Championships at the Worlds, or Com Games or Olympics and am always stunned by how effortlessly they seem to glide across the water. And as for the other strokes like butterfly my mind boggles. Nevertheless, as silly as it sounds, I have always enjoyed the occasional swim mainly to see if I can still do it! Trust me as one gets older it ain't so easy, but I can still manage at least a couple of laps. And it's probably because years ago I had a friend who was an accredited swimming coach and I enjoyed for a time living near a lake. So, 4 mornings a week I swam in the lake. One morning my friend came and watched and was mortified. "I don't know how you haven't sunk." Your hands and feet are all over the place. You've got to get your body moving as one — that is your kicking and your stroke need to be in sync along with your breathing.

I doubt I ever really mastered that advice when it came to swimming. However as I reflect on those words I think that Jesus could well have used the same words to his disciples. Sync or sink — its your choice! What do I mean? Jesus, following his resurrection and knowing he was about to go back home to his Father, urges his disciples to remember what He has told them but wait until they had received the Spirit — ie to sync their dreams, their hopes, their pathways to that of the Spirit before they go anywhere or do anything (Acts 1: 4). Why? Because He knew that without Him (His Spirit) to equip and empower them they would fail in their mission — ie they would sink! And the same goes for you and me. As Paul later reminds us, without Him we are nothing but noise, but with Him we can achieve the impossible. Let's make sure we remain synced with His Spirit as we accept His challenge to go and make disciples, lest we sink!
