RAISING THE BAR!

When I saw a guy alone leaning against a wooden crate for stability when all around me were men chatting, sipping coffee or cold soft drinks, in small clusters of friends and likeminded acquaintances, I felt the tug of the Spirit to go and talk with him. Truthfully, I didn't really want to go, but the prompting became strong. I argued with myself for a time. Do I have to? Surely someone else can befriend him? I'm not sure what to say and besides, I probably won't see him again so why bother? Nevertheless, deep down, despite my uneasiness, I knew what I had to do! It was like I needed to 'raise the bar' – to go – to be obedient. Here was an opportunity to put into practice what I had learnt from years of being a 'Christian'. The next 20 minutes or so was gut wrenching yet powerful and exciting all at once! There was a deep connection and some intimate sharing. He was in a bad space and the future looked grim! We shared about Jesus and His love. He thanked me, we prayed, and we parted company. Some time later I heard that this same guy had given his heart to Jesus, and approaching his future with a different focus.

Today we celebrate the birthday of the Christian church – the coming of the Holy Spirit – Pentecost! And we are told what happened when he came – like Peter became inspired and preached and there were conversion experiences everywhere (Acts 2:14-41). Peter had received an anointing that his Master had told him (and the other disciples) to wait for. Now received, his ministry started with a presence and power that was invitational, intimate, intentional and an identity changer (notice the 4 words!). Folks – the bar had been raised! We today have received this same gift - the Holy Spirit – and it is the Spirit who raises the bar for each one of us. I pray that we may be a church who believes in, and lives out, Pentecostal presence and power and as a result is prepared to raise the bar in our discipleship!
