FREE TO BE!

I remember it all too well! We had been camping at one of the Education Qld outdoor sites not that far from here! It was late May and while the days were great and the sun abounded, the early mornings and evenings were bitterly cold. And out in tents it was even colder. The first and only time I went to sleep with my shoes on – literally! Now we had to hike into the place where we were stationed for the night and we had to hike back to base the next morning (about 5.5 klms each way). We had to carry our own back pack, our tent, sleeping bag or whatever, our food and utensils and clothes. Oh yeah and the most important for some – the roll of toilet paper - but sadly for the girls there was no power so the hair dryer had to stay behind! Gloria was one of the girls on my camp out night. And she appeared at the designated leaving station to begin our trek through the bush with her back pack and 3 plastic bags full of stuff – for one night. I and the other leaders all looked dumbstruck. My immediate thought was how much of the walk and the sights and the things to explore off the beaten track she would miss out on because she would be way too slow because of the extra baggage and be too tired or uninterested because of the extra energy spent on defending her stuff – both of which would surely happen! I knew her pretty well!

Maybe for reasons like that Jesus, when sending the 70 out to prepare the way for Him to come and minister (Luke 10), tells them what not to do as much as what to do. "You won't need to take anything with you- trust in God alone. And don't get distracted from my purpose by anyone you might meet along the way (verse 4 Passion). WOW! Gloria would not have liked that instruction! And if we're honest most of us wouldn't either. Jesus needed his 'sent' people to be focused or as I say – free to be! Free to be yourself with no encumbrances, no baggage, and no distractions. I wonder – do we come to worship free to be? Do we share our faith free to be? Do we enjoy community free to be!
