## PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

## **PEACE PERSONIFIED!**



Peace Peace! Please! This was the cry of the one who was the first to give up in our 'brotherly' duels as kids. Whether it was my actual brother or friends from the church or neighbourhood, one of the things we did was to scrap with each other, and I have to say at times it became quite physical and probably a bit too serious. I remember coming home from those encounters - all in the name of mateship and fun - battered and bruised on more than one occasion. Nonetheless, when you got to the stage that you could do no more and were needing to concede defeat, the fists would thump the ground and the cry would go out – peace peace! And if your foe was kind and considerate, he would release his grip on you, and we'd all go and have a drink. I always thought that yelling out peace was appropriate as surely peace was the absence of fighting – or we may say war or perhaps conflict! I have leant that the peace that Paul talks about is much more then the absence of conflict although that may well be a part of it. Indeed, we are born at war. At birth, our sinful nature has already declared war on God and His truth. Our heart's desire is to be separated from Him, and if we persist in this desire until death, He will give us what we want. But God's methods of warfare are not what we expected. Instead of a battle, He sent us the Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6). Jesus's goal in coming to earth was more than simply to cease conflict; He came to bring about a full and abiding relationship of reconciliation and renewal. And Jesus paid the ultimate price that we may find His peace. Yet, in order to find it and live in it, we need to submit our wills to God's leading and our actions to God's Word, knowing that we can only do so much - the actual results are up to Him. Only God can create peace through the work of the Holy Spirit peace of a harmonious relationship with God.

If we are Spirit-filled, we have a peace that is abundant, available in every situation, and unlike anything that the world has to offer (<u>John 14:27</u>). The alternative to being filled with the Spirit and His peace is to be filled with alarm, filled with doubt, filled with foreboding, or filled with dread. How much better to let the Spirit have control and perform His work of growing fruit to the glory of God! Shalom - Dave
