PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

PERMEATE PATIENCE!



Brian, when I first met him, was a relatively young vivacious English surveyor who had come out from his mother country and for some unexplainable reason settled in Sarina, got a job with Main Roads and lived in a small, poky, lined shipping container. And as I was to discover a solid Christian who connected through what he did more than what he said. Brian was a pain at least to start with. He just found a way to annoy me! He came to church (Dad was the minister) and would sit beside me most Sundays (always the back row). He'd come with this huge bible under his arm and insisted on showing me stuff when I wasn't that interested. I tried hard to ignore him and even tried to get others to ignore him. As I look back now, I am embarrassed! I was so rude to him! Yet, he was so patient with me! He exemplified, I believe, what this 'patience' fruit is all about! He suffered much emotionally, and may be even spiritually, at my expense, yet he never showed anything but care, support and a deep belief in me that I never had! No matter what I said to him (and some of it was not that nice) he would simply look at me and say "ah huh". Seldom agreeing or disagreeing – just affirming my presence! He permeated patience! According to the dictionary, permeate means to penetrate, pass through, and often become widespread throughout something! And this was Brian's presence! It was like an aroma that filled the space he occupied. He never got cranky, angry or even upset (that I could tell) -yet I'm sure he must have felt frustrated at times! Nevertheless, he taught me (eventually) lots about me, my attitude, my lack, and my need! He was one who was very instrumental in me sitting on the cement floor of the church Bell Tower and surrendering my life to Jesus!

The psalmist says, "Rest in the Lord and wait patiently for Him; do not fret because of him who prospers in his way..." (Psalm 37:7). Brian lived this for me and we are called as His followers to live it for others. To live in patience is to suffer for the spiritual welfare of a brother or sister, to count it as a pleasure, and to move with the Spirit and His timing – not yours or theirs! Shalom - Dave
