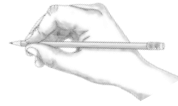

FIRING FAITHFULNESS!

Who can forget John Travolta and Olivia Newton-John in the box-office hit of Grease? Particularly, that moment when Sandy (Olivia) sings – ‘Hopelessly devoted to you’? Confession time – I thought that both sung it to each other, but I have had it from a very reliable source that it was only Sandy who sung it to her new best friend! Well - it’s been a while since I saw it so all you ‘Grease’ tragics – forgive me! My point though is not necessarily who sings it but the depth of the lyrics and the meaning behind them, and specifically when one reflects on faithfulness! You see – faithfulness is all about being devoted – maybe not ‘hopelessly’ but certainly with an unwavering commitment. And this commitment goes to a much deeper level as followers of Jesus! God is faithful – are we? At one time I was employed as a consultant to both major and minor companies around Australia to assist them in their superannuation needs. It was a great job for a time, and I certainly knew what it was like to live consistently out of a suitcase. After a year or so the company I was working for changed its direction and us consultants were told we had to communicate to our clients that we were the best! Now, I knew we were reasonably good, but we were not the best in every facet of superannuation, and I knew that. So, I had a dilemma! Would I be faithful to the company and its new ‘direction’ and who paid me, or would I be faithful to God? Because to me at least I couldn’t commit to both! I chose to ‘fire’ my faith in God (you might say declare it or proclaim it but I like the urgency and purpose behind ‘firing’) and as a result was put on notice. That story ended up well in the end because as it happened my clients went to bat for me and challenged the so-called new direction. (Interestingly it was those few months that began my new direction toward ministry). We read that “the just will live by faith” ([Habakkuk 2:4](#)). We obtain that faith, and our faithfulness, by the grace of God. He is faithful to His children, and by His grace we will one day hear the words, “Well done, good and faithful servant!” ([Matt 25:23](#)).
