PASTOR'S PONDERINGS





What's your approach to life? How do you see your future? What about the future of the Church? Are we resigned to what was or can we see new possibilities and opportunities for enhancing the Kingdom of God here in this place? Are we too consumed by the NOW to embrace and indeed live in the NOT YET? Larry was a farmer who came from a long list of farmers. Unlike his father and his father and his father though, Larry found himself farming ever decreasing patches of land. Eventually through burgeoning community and Government resumptions of land he was down to just a couple of acres. It wasn't enough to sustain him and his family so he began driving his slasher round the neighbourhood seeking other paddocks to slash for a price. He came across Wayne (not his real name) who beckoned him to stop as he was driving past one afternoon. Wayne was a retired guy with little manners, very abrupt, callous in his remarks and demanded Larry slash his 5 acres right now! Larry did, despite not really liking this fellow. When he had finished and went to receive the agreed price, Wayne gave him double the amount asked for. "Here", he said, "good job". Larry was a Christian but not very mature. Still he had been so touched by Jesus that he couldn't help himself. "Thanks mate", Larry says. "you know you were pretty harsh before - what going on for you? A conversation ensued. Larry invites him to church the following Sunday offering to pick him up. Wayne comes - quite unkept and bedraggled but he kept coming back. A few months later He gives his life to Jesus, starts teaching RI at the age of 78 and became rock solid in His faith. Larry could have chosen to see the 'futility' of their first encounter, decline the job and forget about him. But he chose to see beyond the obvious to something bigger and better - He later told me that he just wanted to share Jesus with him - I figured he was 'fertile ground'! Next Sunday is advent!
