PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

REVIEW OR RENEW!

I know! I have shared stories with you before about some of my travels from yesteryear! And if the truth be known I have probably shared something about my love / hate relationship with Dentists. Last Monday morning I found myself sitting in a Dentists chair for over 2 hours and I was less than amused - that is until it was all over. You see when I went for a review of all things teeth and a habitual clean about 3 weeks ago, I was informed that there was one tooth that needed to be drilled and crowned. OUCH! And if that wasn't enough, it was the second last one from the back. DOUBLE OUCH! Travelling to their surgery that morning was not pleasant. I felt like praying that prayer of Jesus (well half of it) in the Garden - Please Lord take this cup from me? I didn't and I turned up and eventually all was done . I remember the words of the Dentist before she started. "This morning we are going to make that tooth at the back like new again." Sometimes renewal is the only option following a review! Such was the case with that tooth. Out with the old filling and in with a crown - much stronger than any filling substance and will outlast it.

I couldn't help but ponder as I left - albeit with sore jaw - the similarities between that experience and our experience when we are confronted with Jesus' Light! Our life is reviewed and we realise that there is junk there that has 'filled' our lives and it is not doing any good! We repent - and allow the Light of Jesus to enter. He does, bringing renewal. As Paul reminds us - "if anyone is in Christ, he / she is a new creation. The old has gone" (2 Cor. 5:17). I often think we in the church spend way too much time in reviewing things instead of allowing Christ by His Spirit to renew us and our customs. There's a place for review but not at the expense of renew! Jesus Light brings renewal of who we are and what we do, say and even think. Lets not be stuck in yesteryear or even yesterday.
