RESCUE MISSION!



From the very first time I went west (with my brother on a train from Brisbane to Roma, then picked up by my Uncle who drove us to Surat, where he was the Anglican Minister - I think I was about 12) I have loved the outback. Yes it certainly has its challenges, but the diversity of its land, its colours and its people have always inspired and intrigued me. I had just arrived in Birdsville on one our annual sojourns to assist Frontier Services during the week of the Races out there. I'd unpacked the Patrol and John (the then Patrol Padre) came running toward his Ute yelling on his way," Dave - jump in, Mark's had an accident and we have to go rescue his bike." Mark was already in the plane heading towards Adelaide hospital! About 2 hours later and some 150 klms down the Birdsville Track we found his bike. It was a bit twisted and the mirrors broken the rear blinker hanging by its electrical cable etc. The mission was to get it onto the back of the ute. Simple! John knew nothing about bikes and so he left it to me to figure out the process! Lying on its side for so long is not good for a bike! I stood it up and waited. Eventually I started it and that was step 1. "OK," said John "how you going to get it onto the ute now. We got no ramps". Improvisation is one of those key ingredients in the outback! No but there's a few anthills. John positioned his ute on one side of one of one of those anthills and the plan was to ride it up the opposite side and jump it onto the back of the ute and stop before I and or the bike hit the cab. Easy! Well Not really. But after a few attempts all was done! Rescue successful! I remember getting back into the car for the trip home nursing a burnt leg - "that was harder than I thought", to which John replied - yep but it was the only way! Jesus comes with a rescue plan, not for bikes but for people! To redeem them - you and I included. His plan was not easy but it was the only way! Enter the Light - The Light of Redemption!
