PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

INTENTIONAL LIVING...

How do we live our life? With purpose? And if so, what purpose? John Maxwell in his book, "Intentional Living: Living a Life that Matters" shares the message behind a movie which was called, "It's A Wonderful Life". He writes: It's the story of George Bailey, a man who dreams of travelling the world and building things, but who instead stays home, because he repeatedly chooses to do what he believes is right for others. George experiences a moment of crisis as he comes to believe that everyone would be better off if he didn't exist—if he'd never been born! His life didn't matter! Then, with the help of an angel, he gets to see what his community would look like if he 'was not around'. George comes to recognise the positive impact he had in others lives. Maxwell says, "we all need to think what we want our story to be? To live a life of significance, that we can and should be doing things that really matter". Do we awaken each morning with the intention of making a difference or do we just go with the flow and 'see what happens'. You know 'whatever will be - will be'? I am sure we've all heard the saying: 'if you fail to plan you plan to fail'. And then there's the cliché: 'promise the world, just don't tell anyone because then it doesn't matter'. And sadly that's so true. Most of us have good intentions! Research suggests though that few actually hold true to their intentions. Living intentionally demands action! "Trust in the Lord, and do good", says the Psalmist (Psalm 37:3). "Faith without action is dead" says James (James 2:17). Jesus himself said, "not everyone who calls me Lord, Lord will enter the Kingdom of Heaven" (Matthew 7:21). We can have all the markings of a people who want to make a difference but unless we act on our intentions - unless they become engrained in who we are and whose we are, they will be no more than words. It's great to chat about growing the Kingdom, and filling our chairs in church - great intentions. Let's remember though that our Commission is to GO., MAKE, BAPTISE , TEACH.
