So if you've been around the last 4 weeks you will have heard about Intimacy, Identity, Intentional and Invitational. 4 I's that if taken seriously will change our world and see our church family grow! Perhaps that's a wild statement and I'll leave you to ponder if you agree or not! But before you wander off allow me to share that in order for that to become real, we have to learn to 'see' with those words and their meaning . There's a school on the Gold Coast who has an interesting tag line! It's a statement that articulates who they strive to be while also reflecting the worth of their students and staff. I served on the Board of that P-12 School for 4 years and discovered that in all their deliberations this statement was at the forefront. "Where everyone is someone", was what drove them and set them apart form the myriad of other private schools. I remember thinking - this could be the tag line for every Church! It could be ours! At least I hope it could! Certainly for Jesus, everyone is someone! The story recorded n John 4 reminds us of how Jesus looks into the heart, knows our secrets, values us highly, and because of His love for us, invites us to change and then share our story.
