PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

BEING AUTHENTIC!

We've spoken about the 4 'I's' and how significant they are if we really want to follow Jesus! And although this word - authentic - doesn't start with I, it seems to me that we cant pretend with our life! You see it is possible for you and I to live a life that appears as though we got it all - that we're intimate, we know our identity, we're intentional and invitational - but deep down we're full of self still. We have to be authentic! Real! Genuine! I share this true story! Loren Cunningham, an ex-international Director of Youth with a Mission began his message to a Christian High School Seniors Graduation night with the question -"Is there anything too hard for God?" After a brief silence there came the response, "No". Then came this question. "Is there anything too hard for God to do through you?" Deathly silence. No one spoke! Sadly that is the case for many of us, me included so often. We keep God's principles and promises at a nice comfortable safe distance! We are happy to say yes to Him and even believe Him for everyone else! Yet, as soon as we are personally challenged to apply His Word to our own lives and experiences we struggle! Deep down we question whether God is really as big and as powerful as He says and we sing! To put it bluntly, we are often pretty good verbal supporters but practical critics. I remember whilst in Gympie, searching for someone to take on a significant leadership role. I approached this relatively new (to the church) family man who I knew was pretty good at computers but I wasn't sure about anything else. I posed the question over a cup of coffee and his response was one I had never heard before and have never heard since. "Well - yeah I'll give it a go-how hard can it be"! What a response. Later he told me that he had no experience in the role he accepted but he trusted that God would provide! And He did! Folks - let's live authentic lives for Jesus. Take Him at His word! Don't pretend! How hard can it be? Shalom Dave!
