PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

LIVING GIVING!

"I wanted to find a few words that encapsulated who my Dad was. And I think these are close. His living was giving and his giving was living." This was how the daughter of a great man concluded her tribute to her Dad. I was privileged to lead that funeral service and to spend some quality time with the family as they came to terms with their loss. And if the truth be known I have used those words (with permission) at several similar services since. I'd encourage you to ponder those words - his living was giving and his giving was living! As we embark together on the privilege we each have to invest into God's space for us and those within our community - I pray we might cherish those same words. But not only cherish them - make them who we are! For me it's the second part of that quote which always challenges me. I reckon most of us can 'give' something as we live. But can we honestly say that our life is 'giving' ie. That all we do, say and think are purposed around our capacity to give - as distinct from our more often used habit of 'hanging on for a rainy day' - or our desire to 'get' and then keep or hoard? Of course when we talk about giving the Jesus way, we are talking about every aspect of our life. But undoubtedly the big ones for most of us are time and money - and the one no-one likes talking about, especially in and around church, is money. Why is that? Maybe you have your own answers to that question and that may well be fine, although I suggest to us all that our giving (yes even our money) is as much a part of following Jesus and being His disciple as prayer, reading His word or involvement in Christian community. The biblical principle is clear! Giving expresses a quality of living that reflects the nature of God (John 3:16). God is a generous giver. He gave all to His Son and His Son gave all for the world (including you and I). God desires to have a family that reflects His nature ie. It's more blessed to give than receive (Acts 20:35). The extent of our giving reflects our heart not our purse, wallet or bank account!
