PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

GO AND TELL

Bek shared her testimony one Sunday morning. She shared the difference between her former life, which was, in her words, horrible and disgusting due to bad choices and her new life as a born again daughter of God. She remarked how as she lay on her lounge room floor and asked Jesus to forgive her and 'do something with her life' that she felt something happening on the inside. "I freaked out a bit", she said, "but then I wondered if this Jesus person really was doing something". After some time lying, weeping, laughing, reflecting on what had happened over the last couple of hours, Bek thought she had done it all. But her life was just beginning! There was so much more for her to do. She said that God had certainly met her and began a transformational work within her, but she could not just stay in that moment, as good as it was. She knew she had to share her story that others might experience what she had.

Bek had a resurrection encounter. She had been brought forth from her tomb and been released into a new day with a new way! Her story reminds me of the encounter that the women had with the risen Lord! One might have expected Jesus and Mary (John 20:16) to sit down right where they were and have a chat about what it was like to be raised from the dead. What dd you feel? Were you aware of everything as it happened? I am sure there could have been so many questions from an inquisitive mind! But instead of that, Jesus refrains from getting to close and tells Mary to go and tell the other disciples. In essence Mary, there's no time to talk about what's not important. We read the same words in each of the 4 Resurrection accounts. "Go and tell". We have come to Sunday by going through Friday and Saturday! There is no other way! We have our Gethsemane, our cross, our death to die, to encounter the Risen Christ. And now, today, what was Friday's "it is finished" becomes "go and tell". Dave.
