PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

JOINING JESUS -

These days if you need to find out how to get somewhere on the road network you probably turn to the cars inbuilt GPS. Or maybe an external one you've bought. GPS stands for "Global Positioning System." 31 Global Satellites provide us with correct directional information 95% of the time anywhere on the surface of the earth. We depend upon those satellites to lead us the right way to go. I didn't say the quickest but not wrong! All we need to do is plug into our navigation system of choice, listen to the voice, follow the directions, and we arrive at our destination stress-free - at least that's what is supposed to happen and generally I guess it does. Such systems give us a sense of security, of control, of comfort, and of assurance that we will get where we want to go. They don't require us to tap into our emotions, to commit to anything much, or to invest a whole lot on our journey, except to keep our eyes on the road and to follow directions. Drivers today mostly want directional indicators for our cars. And lets face it, most of us want directional indicators for our lives to operate the same way! But life is complicated. Life is messy. Life is relational not rational! Joining Jesus is not charting a course to follow, chalking up good deeds or even checking -off sheets of ministry tasks. Rather, it is entering into a spiritual/emotional/dare I say supernatural relationship with Jesus through the invisible presence of the Holy Spirit. Joining Jesus is through an intimate, devoted, committed relationship with Him. Faith in who he is. Trust in the ways he will lead us. Willingness to invest in Him, and allowing Him to direct our lives, even when He takes us in directions that we do not want to go. To join Jesus in His mission, requires us to invest not just our heads but our hearts. That means that we are not always in control. We are told in Luke 7: 11-18 that one crowd meets up with the Jesus crowd. Jesus notices the dead man and intervenes bringing life. When we join Jesus He notices us, intervenes and brings life and joy from the despair of our dark times. We just need to give up charting our course and open up our hearts to the supernatural, invisible, emotional and spiritual presence of Jesus in our life.
