PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

PENTECOST - THE X FACTOR!



Fred Craddock, an American author and teacher shared once of a message he was giving to a group of students training for the ministry. One of the students stood up before Fred began and asked an interesting and somewhat probing question. "Before you start Sir, I need to know if you are Pentecostal." There was a hush over the whole auditorium. Craddock wondered how he should respond? How would we? It was obvious that this student wasn't going to let him off - he stood there and waited. Eventually Craddock replied, "Do you mean do I belong to the Pentecostal Church?" Somewhat impatiently the student retorted, "No, I mean are you Pentecostal"? "Are you asking if I'm charismatic?" "No, are you Pentecostal?" "Do you want to know if I speak in tongues?" By now this student was quite agitated and almost yelled, "for the last time, are you Pentecostal? Craddock finally replied, "I'm sorry I don't know what you're asking". At that the student left with the words, "Obviously you are not Pentecostal." How might we respond to that same question? Perhaps Craddock could be forgiven in that he most likely would have understood Pentecost to be a one day event - never to be repeated. And he would be right! The day of Pentecost was and only ever will be a once only Holy Spirit awakening. Yet the benefits of that day - a communicative spirit, a joyful spirit, a thankful spirit and a serving spirit live on and remain with us. For the Christian the Spirit is the X Factor. Difficult to explain, hard to understand, impossible to see or touch or smell yet so alive and crucial to our calling to be His witnesses. The Holy Spirit, whose coming we celebrate today, brings new life to those who believe in Jesus and with that life, comes a continuing power to ensure that those same folk are continually filled. It means a fire in our gut, burning away the chaff and flaming out to all around us. This Spirit enables the Gospel to go out boldly in ways never before even dreamt about! Do we live out the infilling of the Spirit? Or as I often say - have we activated the Spirit within us so that he is our go to for protection, permission, provision, purpose, position, presence and power? If our answer is yes - then we are Pentecostal. We carry the X-Factor! Shalom Dave
