PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

ALIVE, ALIGHT & ALERT



Ever bought a book purely on the front cover? Probably not really a wise thing to do but I did it on this occasion. The book was entitled "The Man who would not be Defeated" and on the front cover was a quote "It's not what happens to you; it's what you do about it". I was intrigued. I confess to thinking that it must be a Christian book but I was wrong. Yet, it was one book (and there are very few of them) that I could not out down. Not Christian but true. Not Christian but so much Christian perspective! This book is Bill Mitchell's autobiography. He knows what it is like to be alight and alive. A traffic accident when he was in his early twenties (1971) saw him literally lit up with exploding petrol such that 80% of his body was badly burnt and scarred - yet he defied death. He was alive and conscious through much of the searing and gruesome pain that followed. Four years later he crashes in his own plane (he was an accomplished pilot) and suffered permanent damage to his spine. So now this twisted, scarred body is confined to a wheelchair for the rest of his days. Yet, he was alive still. And not just alive but alert to his situation and determined to soldier on and make a difference. Indeed it was those near death experiences that was the catalyst for a new way of looking at life. Was he going to allow his tragedies to define him and limit him forever or would he use these same incidents to define who he could become? He chose intentionally the latter. Almost 50 years on, these life changing events are not his focus. Anthony Robbins, good friend of Bill and Christian motivational speaker writes, "Mitchell embodies traits required to rise above whatever is thrown at you, enabling you to be joyful, fulfilled and a whole being created in the image of God"

Paul encourages us to be alive, alight and alert too albeit thankfully in a very different way. He urges us to be alive in Jesus, alight by His Spirit and alert to all around us in order to be a witness to His saving grace. We are to confess Jesus and be raised to a light filled world. You and I have the same choice as Mitchell had! Will we be defined by the way we and things were or be made new and be defined by the way we and things can become. And your choice is.........
