Ever had a change of feeling sweep over you? Perhaps after a busy day, you get home and feel exhausted, tired and just want to chill. Then the phone rings and someone close to you - maybe a son or daughter, husband, wife, grandma etc excitedly tells you that they have just been notified of their winning some competition and the prize is an all expenses paid holiday to some place they always wanted to go. They are so excited! And all of a sudden you feel their energy and enthusiasm and now you feel full of life. I vividly recall feeling very flat and guite alone one Saturday morning not long after arriving in Gympie. I had no idea where anything was, had not met too many people vet and desperately needed to find a clothes repairer to fix my trousers zip - so as to avoid extreme embarrassment the next morning at my first service in this new place. I had walked both sides of Mary Street and saw no such shop despite Mr Google telling me it existed. I sat on a Park Bench and was thinking through my options when this older woman stopped and said, "You look lost. Can I help?" I don't think I even raised my eyes, but simply said, "I'm sorry. I'm new to town and an frustrated because I can't find what I'm looking for." And I told her the shop I needed. "If you can just tell me the street address, I'll find it." Then I got up and she said - "walk this way". "Where are you taking me", I quipped. Before I could say anything else, she replied, "With me." On the way to that shop, she stopped and told me all about the town she loved. Then on arriving at the 'shop', she came in, introduced me to the shop owner and asked her to make sure she looked after me. She put a new zip in while I waited, gave me a cup of coffee and then refused to accept any payment. From feeling alone and quite agitated to feeling affirmed, loved and appreciated all because of two words with me. She went beyond the normal and her gift to me that day was priceless. God has always been in the business of 'with me'. If you are with me then no one or no thing can stand against you. If you are with me, you don't need to be afraid. If you are with me, you can achieve the impossible for me. The question He asks is, "are you with me?" And how you respond is your choice?
