PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

PURPOSEFUL PLACE!

Ok - I'll be up front. This is a dog story! And I know that some of you may turn off straight away because you're not into dogs or maybe you prefer cats or some other form of pet comforter (like my nephew Nathan and his pet Python and Red Belly Black) but I ask that you humour me and read on anyway. And for the dog lovers amongst us - may you be inspired! I've had a number of dogs over the years but the one breed that always captivates me and still my favorite is the German Shepherd., probably because Mum and I bred Shepherds for a few years (Mum did most of the work). But one needs lots of space and time to gain the most of this breed. Jazz was my latest . I got her when she was about 2 from a breeder discovering at that time she was abused as a pup (the breeder found her on the side of the road one night and took her in). Jazz and I became mates . I could tell you many stories but today just this one! I was walking her one Friday night. It was late and quite dark. Jazz was on my left - her usual place when we walked - and rarely did she move from my side . We were about 200 meters from the road and suddenly she stopped and dug her feet in (so to speak). I pulled on her lead but she froze and kept looking to her right - toward a thick set of bushes. Just as I was becoming guite frustrated and angry at her, something in that bush moved. I now froze and Jazz barked but never moved making sure she was between me and whatever was in there! It seemed like an eternity we were there neither of us moved until Jazz was sure that there was danger lurking. What was it? I have my guesses but I don't know! What I do know is that Jazz had a reason to be where she was at that time and if being there meant she was naughty or yelled at - too bad. It's like she was saying, "you and I are one and you need me as I need you! I had a purpose to be in that place."
